Dos	Don'ts
 Observe good conduct and orderly behaviour Respect and behave properly with other students and staff (teaching & nonteaching) Carry Identity Card issued by the University and/or Hostel Immediately inform Security/Proctorial Board about any sensitive matter that you come across Inform Security/Proctorial Board about presence of any unauthorised outsider inside University premises Inform Proctorial Board in case of non-compliance of the rules or instructions by a student Follow traffic rules and cooperate with security personnel Wear helmet while driving a motorbike Maintain cleanliness and dine at specified place Enter into class in time and be regular in attendance Regularly pay attention to notice boards and the University website Maintain silence nearby classrooms, labs and library 	Don't pass coloured (caste, gender, communal etc.) or sensitive remarks or sarcastic comments or gestures towards peers and staff Don't inflict physical assault, threat to use physical force, or any other intimidating behaviour Don't disrupt or disturb in any manner in the teaching and other works of the university Don't visit the places declared 'Out of Bounds' for the students or go to restricted areas including rooftop and restricted terraces Don't possess and distribute objectionable goods or materials Don't shut or bolt the doors of a classroom/ lab/ hall etc. from inside in absence of a eacher Don't misuse/tamper with the teaching aids and devices including digital devices Don't triple-ride on a motorbike Don't damage or tamper with University property in any form Don't possess, display, use, or threat of use, of any weapon Don't do an act that causes, encourages or implies the interference of outside persons, organisations or authorities Don't consume or keep intoxicating substances like tobacco, alcohol, narcotics etc.
