Chancellor of Central University of South Bihar (CUSB) started on August 5, 2015, and in this short period of time I witnessed a number of activities, happenings, achievements and developments. My first goal i.e. the zeal and enthusiasm to see CUSB among one of the best institutions of the region and country motivated me to start the building construction work at University's permanent campus at Panchanpur in Gaya as soon as possible. Thankfully, the sincere efforts made from our end resulted into the foundation stone laying ceremony of seven buildings on 31st August 2015 by Hon'ble Minister of Human Resource Development (MHRD) Smt. Smriti Zubin Irani. The building construction work is in full swing and we are expecting to shift into our own campus by December 2016. The intention behind recording these lectures is to ensure good quality teaching besides making the class room lecture available to the students as and when they want to hear again and to those students who for some reasons or other miss their classes. The University has decided to go for total E-governance wherein these video recorded lectures will be uploaded each day for the access of the students online wherever and whenever they wish to do so. This will also help the University to contribute significantly in the MHRD's initiative to launch Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs), as the selected good lectures of the faculty would also be uploaded on the Central Portal of MOOCs website thereby strengthening the Govt. of India initiative of availability of MOOCs for the general use under its SWAYAM programme. All these activities and initiatives altogether would surely take the University to a new high on the path of academic excellence and its motto of "Collective Reasoning". Achieving success is of course a daunting task, and for this I congratulate my team of experienced faculty, accomplished officers, skilled staff and bright students. But the important thing is maintaining the level as one of the region's best institution for higher education, and to overcome the challenges coming on way. I am signing off with the full confidence on my team that in the coming years with combined efforts and dedication of all CUSB would scale to epitome of higher studies.

### **April 2015**

#### Lecture by BARC Scientist Dr. S. Gautam

Dr. S. Gautam, Head, Food Science & Safety Section, Food Technology Division in Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC), Mumbai delivered a lecture at CUSB Patna campus on **April 5, 2015.** In the lecture organised by the Centre for Biological Sciences (CBS), Dr. Gautam explained the use of radiation energy in context to India including food security, availability of the food, safety, importance of the food and the status of country in international trade (export of products).



The BARC scientist said that India is second largest producer of cereals, vegetables and fruits after China, along with being the biggest producer of spices, in which BARC has given significant contribution. Along with food sector, BARC is also doing research in agriculture sector for developing new varieties of crops, health sector in which radio isotope is used for Cancer diagnosis and radiation therapy, and also the water sector for finding the ways to purify the drinking water, mentioned Dr. Gautam.

#### Seminar on birth anniversary of Dr. Ambedkar

On the occasion of birth anniversary of Bharat Ratna Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar a seminar was organised at CUSB Gaya campus on **April 14, 2015**. # International Conference on Recent Advances in Mathematics, Statistics and Computer Science (ICRAMSCS)

The School of Mathematics, Statistics and Computer Science of CUSB organised a three day conference "International Conference on Recent Advances in Mathematics, Statistics and Computer Science (ICRAMSCS)" during May 29-31, 2015 in Patna. The international conference was inaugurated at conference hall of Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) Patna complex. Prof. Arun Kumar Sinha, General Chair of ICRAMSCS in his welcome speech expressed his gratitude towards the speakers and participants for attending the conference despite their busy schedules. He said it's wonderful to see academicians, scientists, scholars and industry professionals here to discuss the modern technological tools and its usage for the society, nation and developing world. Prof. G. P. Patil, former faculty at The Pennsylvania State University, University Park, PK, USA gave the inaugural speech on the topic 'Multivariate Ranking, Prioritization, and Selection in Multivariate Non-Parametric Statistics using Discrete Mathematics Partial Order for Comparative Knowledge Discovery in Multi-Indicator Information Fusion Systems with Multi-Disciplinary Applications: Recent Past, Exciting Present, and Near Future'.



In the keynote address Prof. Bhu Dev Sharma from J.P Group of Institute, Ghaziabad spoke on the topic 'Some Advances in Coding, Vagueness Measures and Aggregation Operators'. Further, Prof. B.K Sinha from Indian Statistical Institute (ISI) Kolkata spoke on quite contemporary and interesting topic 'SuDoKu Puzzles – A Combinatorial Marvel'. The keynote address session commemorated with the speech of Prof. J. N. Singh, Barry University, Florida, USA who spoke on the topic 'The Interior-Point Revolution in Mathematical Programming and its place in Applied Mathematics'. For three days a number of papers were presented by renowned academicians, noted people from industry, research scholars and students on various topics related to Mathematics, Statistics and Computer Science.

#### Central University of South Bihar Entrance Test (CUSBET) – 2015

The online entrance test Central University of South Bihar Entrance Test (CUSBET) for admission in various programmes was conducted on May 30 & 31, 2015. The test was conducted at 15 centres (cities) viz. Patna, Ara, Bhagalpur, Biharsharif, Darbhanga, Gaya, Muzaffarpur and Purnea in Bihar, Ranchi and Jamshedpur (Jharkhand), Kolkata (West Bengal), Allahabad and Lucknow in Uttar Pradesh, New Delhi and Hyderabad. Candidates appeared for admission in four undergraduate programmes, namely Four-Year Integrated B.A / B.Sc BEd, Five-Year Integrated B.A / B.Sc LL.B (Hons), 16 postgraduate programmes that included Bioinformatics, Biotechnology, Computer Science (both MSc & MTech), Environmental Science, Life Science, Mathematics, Statistics, Communication and Media Studies, Development Studies, Economics, English, Psychology, Political Science and Sociology except Hindi (offline test was conducted at CUSB Patna). The entrance test for admission in integrated MPhil - PhD programmes was also conducted for seven subjects. CUSBET results were declared on June 4, and successful candidates appeared in written test / interview during June 15 - 20, 2015. The admission formalities completed in the month of June 2015 for all programmes.


#### **July 2015**

### August 2015

#### **New Vice-Chancellor of CUSB assumed office**

After a gap of about 17 months, CUSB got new Vice-Chancellor Prof. Harish Chandra Singh Rathore who assumed duties on **August 05, 2015**. Prof. Rathore assumed charge as second VC of the University from acting VC Prof. Debdas Banerjee in presence of Registrar (Acting) Dr. (Mrs) C. L. Prabhavati. A DAAD and Humbolt fellow, Prof. Rathore is having a very vast and impressive academic and administrative experience. Before joining CUSB, Prof Rathore was the Dean of Faculty of Education at Banaras Hindu University (BHU), Varanasi. He was also the co-ordinator of Internal Quality Assurance Cell of BHU. He had been the Chief Proctor of BHU for the period of about six years.



He has received many fellowships and awards for his contributions to the field of Education. Prof. Rathore is member of several national committees constituted by MHRD, UGC, NAAC and NCTE, along with membership of more than a dozen professional national and international bodies. One the first day, following a brief inspection of CUSB Patna campus, Prof. Rathore addressed to media persons during a press conference and urged to make CUSB an institute of national repute. While talking with media, he hinted to shift the University to permanent campus at Gaya very soon.

Hon'ble minister was accompanied by Mr. Ram Kumar Sharma, Member of Parliament, MLC Mr. Krishna Kumar Singh, Dr. Anil Kumar, Member of Legislative Assembly from Tikari (Gaya), Mr. Vinay Sheel Oberoi, Secretary, Dept. of Higher Education among many others on the dais. The Union minister laid the foundation of seven buildings of CUSB under first Phase, namely, Central Office, School of Earth, Biological and Environmental Sciences, School of Social Sciences & Policy, Boys Hostel, Girls Hostel, Lecture complex and Dining hall.

CUSB Vice-Chancellor Prof. H.C.S Rathore in his welcome address

thanked the Union Minister for her presence despite busy schedule. In his brief speech the VC presented the facts along with present status about the University. He had also put his demand for establishment of a Kendriya Vidyalaya in the University premises for the children of faculty members and staff, which was later given green nod by the Hon'ble Minister.

Further, Smt. Irani started her speech in a lighter note and said every second student present among the audience is possessing a smartphone. Hence, for meeting the requirements of such students, government is having a programme called 'Campus Connect' which provides free internet connectivity in the campus. I wish to provide free Wi-Fi to students of the University. Specially speaking about the research scholars, she said for such students we are trying to start a project named as 'E-sodh Sindu' probably by January 2016 through which the Journals, E-books related to research may be provided free of cost. The minister mentioned about the start of special programme under 'Global Initiative of Academic Network (GIAN)' probably in November 2015, in which foreign academician would provide free education to Indian students and the cost would be borne by government. Expressing her concern for financially weak students, the minister said that for

such people the government is going to take an initiative called 'Swyam'. Referring to 'Unnat Bharat Abhiyan' project, the minister urged the University to adopt five villages from the vicinity so that they get enlightenment of education. The vote of thanks was proposed by Acting Registrar Dr. (Mrs.) C.L. Prabhavathi followed by National Anthem the programme ended.

#### Roundtable discussion on Bihar floods

The Centre for Environmental Sciences of CUSB organised a roundtable discussion on the topic "The Agony of Rivers: Floods in Bihar" on **September 3, 2015** at Hotel Maurya in Patna in collaboration with the Himalayan Adaptation, Water and Resilience (HI-AWARE) Research Initiative of the International Centre for Integrated Mountain Development (ICIMOD) and Megh Payne Abhiyan.

Prof. Singh said mental illness is curable if treatment is done under the consultation of psychologist on time.

#### Lecture of US-based scientist Dr. Dhruv Kumar

CUSB's Centre for Biological Sciences (CBS) organised a talk by US based Indian scientist Dr. Dhruv Kumar on **November 23, 2015**. Dr. Kumar delivered the talk on "Metabolic symbiosis between tumor-associated fibroblasts and head and neck squamous cell carcinoma". In his talk Dr. Kumar highlighted the disease caused by Cancer cells in head and neck, and the molecular mechanisms involved in head and neck squamous cell carcinoma (HNSCC) progression. Dr. Kumar shared the fact that usually people think that neck and head cancer is caused by use of tobacco product, but betelnut (supari) also causes cancer. Speaking about the remedies to protect oneself from the attack of cancer, Dr. Kumar stressed upon the need of eating the half-boiled food as the nutritional value of the food decreases with deep cooking and deep fry. He said the anti-cancer components are found in turmeric, green tea, and vegetables like cauliflower, cabbage, broccoli etc.

#### **Constitution Day Celebration**

School of Law & Governance of CUSB celebrated the Constitution Day on **November 26, 2015** in honour of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar. A number of activities were organised on this day including introductory speech by Dr. Pradip Kr. Das, presidential address by Dr. Alok Kr. # International Conference on Human Implications of Biotechnology (ICHIB) - 2016

The Centre for Biological Sciences (CBS) of CUSB organised "First International Conference on Human Implications of Biotechnology" (ICHIB) - 2016 during February 12-14, 2016. The three day conference formally inaugurated in presence of CUSB Vice-Chancellor Prof. H.C.S Rathore, chief guest Prof. Asif Ahmed, Dr. R. S. Rathore and Dr. Rizwanul Haque from CBS. Prof. Amrendra Narayan Misra from Central University of Jharkhand was also present as co-oraniser of the conference. Prof. Asif Ahmed gave a plenary talk on the topic 'Risky business of pregnancy'. He dealt about 'Pre-eclampsia', a pregnancy disorder characterised by high blood pressure and high protein in urine. Usually it occurs one in every 50 pregnant women with symptoms like seizures, strokes, premature baby death and death of mother. Prof. Ahmed said that he in company of scientists is studying about the disorder to develop new and affordable therapy for pregnancy complications.



CUSB VC Prof. H.C.S. Rathore said that Biotechnology is really good for human beings but the basic social values must not be ignored. He urged from the researchers to develop medicines for deadly diseases and finding out the ways for decomposition of waste materials. On the inaugural day, CUSB signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Aston University of United Kingdom (UK) for research on Stem Cell therapy, Drug Designing therapy, Mental health, etc. In the three day conference many papers, talks and posters, were presented by around 500 delegates comprised of experts, scientists, researchers and students.






# **Growth of CUSB during 2009-16**







