

I do believe in same and tried to justify it with my sincere efforts in ensuring all-round development of the University by going hand-in-hand with my team comprised of faculty, officers, staff and students. I am delighted to bring the latest edition of Newsletter – CUSB Times, 2016-17 carrying the achievements and success stories of the University. Further, CUSB bagged '**A**' grade from the **NAAC (National Assessment and Accreditation Council)**, which was officially notified on 25th May, 2016. The highly talented faculty members, besides their regular teaching and research curriculum actively participated in co-curricular activities including seminars, workshops, conferences, papers / articles / books publications, etc. The active participation of students in University level activities as well as other reputed educational institutions of the country was equally praiseworthy. Both the faculty as well as students with their participation in such activities brought laurels for the University.

Before I conclude, I feel the one-year period would be somehow incomplete without specifically mentioning about the '**Digital Economy**' campaign, which ran successfully in the University as per the guidelines received from MHRD, Govt. of India. Under my guidance the faculty, staff and students enthusiastically participated in VISAKA (Vittiya Saksharata Abhiyan) and the University swiftly transformed to become 'cashless' in all types of transactions. Lastly, we are committed towards our goal to develop CUSB as a Centre of '**Academic Excellence**' in the region, which seems achievable with combined efforts of University's stakeholders amidst the pristine surroundings of **Panchanpur at Gaya – our splendid upcoming campus.**

Major Achievements

NAAC Accredited "A" Grade to CUSB



The Central University of South Bihar (CUSB) bagged 'A' grade from the NAAC (National Assessment and Accreditation Council), which was notified after the 15th meeting of the Standing Committee held on 25th May, 2016. An eight-member NAAC Peer Review Team led by Prof. Mehraj-Ud-Din Mir, Vice-Chancellor of Central University of Kashmir made an inspection to Patna and Gaya campuses of the University during April 26 – 29, 2016. Prof. Mir was accompanied by Prof. K.K. Bajaj (Member Co-ordinator), former Dean CDC & Controller of Examinations, Himachal Pradesh University, Prof. S. B. Singh, former Principal RIE, Ajmer, Head, School of Life Sciences, Devi Ahilya University, Indore, Dr. M. Vimala, Dept. of Hindi, Bangalore University, Prof. Nasib Singh Gill, Dept. of Computer Science, Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak, Prof. R. K. S. Dharkrey, Dept. of Chemistry, Dr. Ambedkar University, Agra and Prof. G. P. Thakur, former Prof. of Psychology, Mahatma Gandhi Kashi Vidyapeeth. The NAAC Peer Team in its four-day long trip inspected the available resources and amenities of the University, interacted with faculty, staff and students including alumni and their parents, and awarded 'A' grade accordingly.

NIRF 2016 – CUSB ranked as No.1 University of Bihar

In the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) ranking declared by Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Govt. of India on 4th April, 2016, CUSB was listed among top 100 Universities of the country. By securing 94th position, CUSB became the only University in Bihar to find a place in NIRF ranking and secured 1st position in the state as well.

UGC / MHRD EVENTS

International Yoga Day (21st June, 2016)

On the occasion of globally acclaimed International Day of Yoga, CUSB organised a special one-hour Yoga practicing session on June 21, 2016. The session conducted under the supervision of CUSB VC Prof.



H.C.S Rathore, was led by DSW Dr. Sanat Kr. Sharma as per the Common Yoga Protocol (CYP) structured by the Ministry of Ayush, Govt. of India. The one-hour session started with the prayer in meditative posture called Namaskara Mudra. The CYP Yoga was undertaken in various Yogaasana (Yoga postures) such as standing postures, sitting postures, prone lying postures, and supine lying postures.

'Azaadi 70' Pakhwada (August 9 - 23, 2016)

As per the guidelines received from MHRD, CUSB celebrated the 'Azaadi 70' pakhwada (Independence



70 - fortnight) during August 09-23, 2016. The University organised various activities on the theme of "Yaad Karo Qurbani". The motive behind the fortnight celebrations was to learn about the sacrifices in the India's freedom struggle with the active involvement of University's faculty members, staff and students. The fortnight Azaadi 70 celebration concluded in the morning of August 23 with the group singing of National Anthem led by CUSB Vice-Chancellor Prof. H.C.S. Rathore.

Swachh Bharat Pakhwada (September 1-15, 2016)

The University observed the Swachh Bharat Pakhwada during September 1-15, 2016, as per the instructions of UGC and MHRD, Govt. of India.



The pakhwada was organised with main thrust in the activities like upkeep & cleaning of offices including common area premises, toilets, stairs, etc., and areas outside the office including parking lots, pathways, etc. A number of activities were organised during this pakhwada, which witnessed active participation from students, faculty, staff and officers including VC, Pro-VC, Registrar, DSW, Proctor and Wardens.

Vigilance Awareness Week (November 14-19, 2016)

Based on the guidelines received from Central Vigilance Commission (CVC), CUSB observed the



Vigilance Awareness Week (VAW) during November 14-19, 2016. Various activities were organised under the supervision of CVO Mrs. Rashmi Tripathi and co-ordinator VAW Dr. Kinshuk Pathak, Asst. Prof., CMS. An essay writing competition was organised on the topic "Public Participation in Promoting Integrity and Eradicating corruption". Under the VAW, the University fraternity took the pledge to continuously strive to bring about integrity and transparency in all spheres of their activities.

Cashless India Drive (12th Dec, 16 - 31st March, 2017)

CUSB ran a massive awareness campaign for "Cashless India", starting from 12th December, 2016, which continued till 31st March, 2017. The awareness campaign ran under the supervision of VC Prof. H.C.S. Rathore. The students, faculty, officers and staff were made aware about the cashless transaction and its modes such as USSD, Aadhar, Cards, PoS, e-Wallet and UPI. Within a short-span CUSB started cashless transactions for almost all types of payment including fee. Under the drive the students visited different areas in Patna and Gaya, and made people aware about digital transaction



through street-plays, posters, banners, slogans and quiz competition. The groups of students also hold the helpdesk at the nearby banks for making the customers aware about the digital transaction. In fact, in the Vittiya Saksharata Abhiyan (VISAKA), the University fared very well and secured its place among the top 10 institutions of the country in the number of registered participants.

IMPORTANT DAYS

Independence Day (15th August, 2016)

With the hearts soaked in patriotic feeling, the CUSB family celebrated the Independence Day. The national tri-colour was hoisted by CUSB VC Prof. H.C.S. Rathore and Pro VC Prof. O.P. Rai in Patna and Gaya campuses respectively. After hoisting the national flag the Vice-Chancellor in his speech spoke about the responsibilities of a citizen as an



Indian and being a true patriot. He said the basic moral values of a child comes from the mother, hence the teachings of mother should be given prime importance in order to make India a beautiful and prosperous nation. While at Gaya, the Pro VC expressed his views about the Independence Day and significance of the independence for the country and its people. Mesmerising cultural



programmes were presented by the students under the supervision of University's Cultural Activities Committee at both the campuses. A skit portraying the pre and post-independence era of India was the major highlight of the programme, which received huge plaudits from the audience.

Republic Day (26th January, 2017)

'Self-governance is my birth right' but at the same time responsibility comes on our shoulders to justify the same with our sincere and active involvement in nation building, said Prof. H.C.S. Rathore, VC, CUSB during his Republic Day address at Patna campus. **Lokmanya Titak** didn't say that self-governance is 'our' birth right, in fact, he said self-governance is 'my' birth right. This literally means that we all citizens of India are equally responsible for nation building and managing its affairs, said Prof. Rathore. The cultural programmes, skits, songs, qawwali, dance, etc. presented by the students were highlights of the Republic Day celebrations. With the aim to ease out the chaos caused due to the demonetization decision taken by Hon'ble Prime



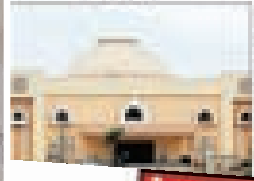
