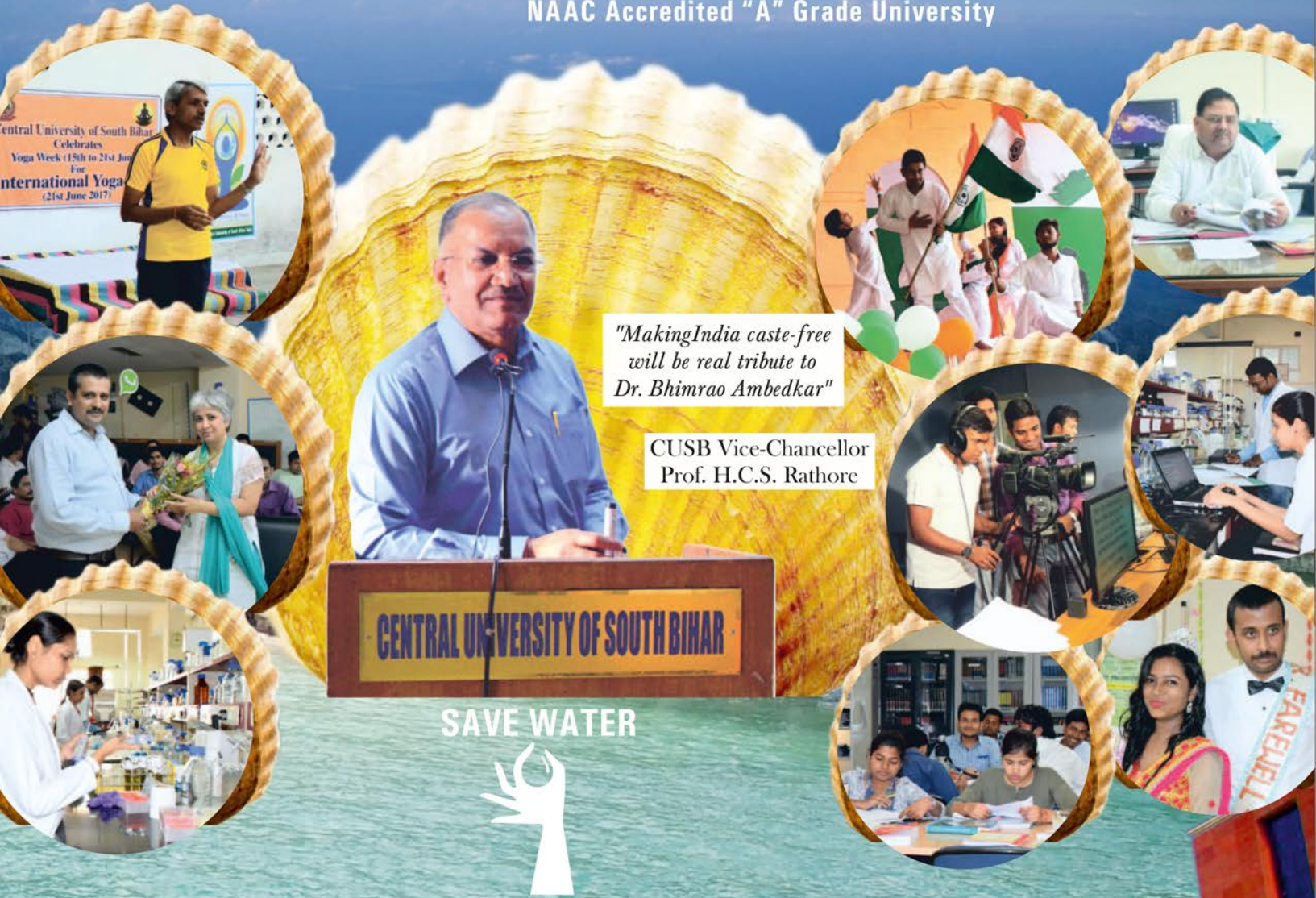

CUSB organised various events (activities) under the 'Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat' during the first week of May, 2017 as per the guidelines received from UGC / MHRD. The purpose of the weekly celebration was to make the students, faculty and staff aware about the ideologies of unity, integrity and excellence of India. As per the direction given by the Vice-Chancellor Prof. Harish Chandra Singh Rathore the events were organised under the supervision of Dean Students' Welfare Dr. Sanat Kumar Sharma.

**Talk on Tribals of Jharkhand  
 (06th April, 2017)**

The Academic Committee of CUSB organised a talk on the topic 'Economic Transformations among the Tribals of Jharkhand' on 6th April, 2017. Dr. Ambrish Gautam, Asst. Prof., Centre for Sociological Studies in his talk traced the transformation of tribal economy in Jharkhand from pre-agricultural mode of life to modern-global industrial life. He cited examples of various tribal communities like Santhal, Birhor, Oraon, Munda, Ho, etc. of state of Jharkhand. Dr. Gautam described innumerable socio-economic exchanges of tribals by quoting shifting and jhum cultivation, barter, potalash, bracelet and neckless exchange, etc., which represent important economic activity of reciprocity. He concluded his talk by claiming that tribals in Jharkhand have now become largely labourers in era of global economic activity, who were earlier master of their own fate. The participants in the discussion were faculty members and students of the university. Among others, Dr. Sanat Kumar Sharma, DSW, Prof. S. N. Singh (Dean, School of SSP), Prof. S. K. Srivastava (Dean, School of Law) and Prof P. K. Singh (Dean School of Languages) were present. The talk was introduced by Dr. Haresh Narayan Pandey (co-ordinator, Academic Committee) and the vote of thanks was extended by Dr. Pankaj Kumar Mishra (the Committee member).

**Ambedkar Jayanti

He compared CBCS with conventional system. Choice Based Credit System, has greater flexibility as compared to the conventional way of teaching and learning process. Students have the freedom to choose number of courses offered in a semester. The benefit of this system is that the student can choose the course of her/his interest according to her/his capability of learning. As regards CBCS evaluation, UGC has developed grading system and method for computing the Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) and Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) based on the performance of the students in the examination. It aims to bring uniformity across different universities in India. As Dr. Basantia pointed out, semester system accelerates the teaching learning process and enables vertical and horizontal mobility in learning. At the end, the discussion was open for all the participants where the faculty

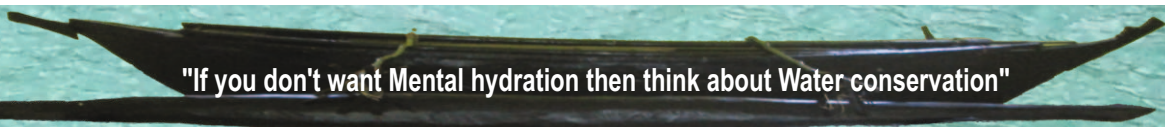

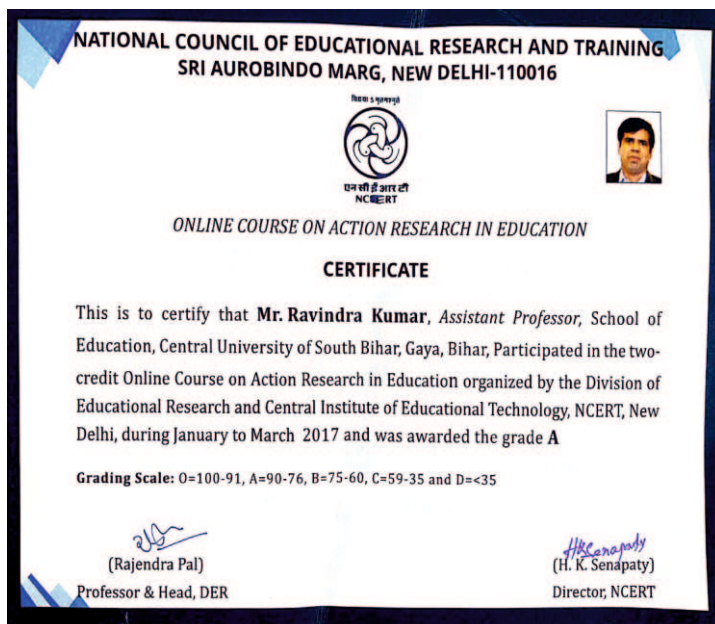
